

Zone 5 inner

Section 4, Chislehurst to Bromley South

Distance: 3.67 mi, 5.87 km

Introduction

This is a fairly short and straightforward section. The first half is suburban, but not as soulless as one might expect. The remainder is more varied.

There are pubs and places to eat at the end.

Directions

Turn right out of Chislehurst Station and descend to the main road.

Turn right under the railway, then right into Woodlands Road.

After a left bend and a climb, turn left into St George's Road.

Cross a couple of roads and a railway line.

At the end, turn left along Oldfield Road.

Turn right into Springfield Road.

Take the footpath on the right, after no. 2.

Keep straight ahead along Park Hill.

Cross the main road, and carry on along another footpath, followed by a short stretch of road, followed by yet another footpath.

Keep straight ahead along the left-hand edge of Whitehall Recreation Ground (on either of the two parallel paths).

On leaving the park, carry on along a residential road to the end.

At the end, turn left along Bromley Common.

Turn right into Hook Farm Road.

After the first yellow barrier turn right.

Pass the carpark on the left and another yellow barrier.

Go round a left bend.

Just before another carpark, go through a gap in the fence on the right and follow a rough path through the wood.

At the end, turn left along a track.

Turn right along the edge of a carpark.

Keep straight ahead past a triangular carpark on the left.

Then go straight ahead along the left-hand edge of another carpark.

Bear left then right into yet another carpark, and keep straight on out through the exit. (Initially you can follow a grass path just to the right of the driveway.)

At the main road, turn right then immediately left along a footpath.

At the fork, bear left.

Keep straight ahead along Cromwell Close.

Turn left at the main road, then right into St Marks Road.

Go up the steps and bear left into the carpark.

Bromley South Station is on your right.
