

Zone 5 inner

Section 12 : West Sutton to Stoneleigh

Distance: 2.81 mi, 4.50 km

Introduction

This is a short but pleasant section. Much of it is through Cheam Park and Nonesuch Park. Whitehall, in the centre of Cheam, is an interesting survival.

There is a pub in Cheam and one in Stoneleigh.

Directions

On leaving West Sutton Station, turn left along the main road.

Turn right into Perretts Field, between nos. 83 and 81.

When you come out into the open, keep straight ahead across the grass.

On the far side, turn left onto a tarmac path.

At a fork bear right.

At the next intersection, bear left then right.

Turn right in front of a play area.

Bear right up some steps to the main road.

Cross the main road, and carry on along Spring Close Lane.

Turn left at the next two T junctions.

Bear right twice along Park Road.

At the main road, keep straight on down Park Lane.

When the road bends left, turn right past a yellow and black barrier.

Before the next barrier, bear left.

Keep straight on, then, just before a carpark turn left.

After a gate in a green metal fence, turn left.

A little after a gate in a similar fence, turn right, and carry on with the fence on your right.

When houses appear on the right, turn left.

Proceed along the left-hand edge of an expanse of open grassland.

Bear left along a tarmac path, and carry on along the right-hand edge of another expanse of grassland.

At the next intersection, turn right.

Turn left before a line of trees.

As the path curves round to the left, take a narrow path on the right into the trees.

On leaving the trees, bear left.

Keep left along the edge of the grass.

At the end, take the path into the trees on the right.

Cross the main road, and carry on along the footpath opposite.

Keep going, across several residential roads.

At the last one, turn left.

At the end, turn right.

Keep straight ahead, to reach Stoneleigh Station.
